FEEDBACK AND COMPLAINTS

Doctors and staff at this Practice are committed to providing you with a high standard of patient care. Patient input plays an important role in helping us improve care to our patients. If you have a suggestion, please place these in the suggestion box available at reception. All suggestions are then discussed at the staff meetings and if possible acted upon.

If you have a complaint, please either phone or write to the Practice Manager or your doctor stating the nature of the issue. We always endeavour to resolve complaints directly with the patient, however if you are unsatisfied the NSW Health Complaints Commissioner can be contacted by the practice or the patient for advice and possible mediation. MANAGEMENT OF PATIENT HEALTH INFORMATION

Your medical document is a confidential document. The practice ensures that only authorised members of staff have access to your information and that all staff complies with the *Privacy Amendment Act 2000*.

Patients of our practice have the right to access their personal health information under the *Privacy Amendment (Private Sector) Act 2000*. The Practice requires all requests for health records in writing addressed to your GP.

TRANSFERRING MEDICAL RECORDS

Should you wish to transfer your records to another treating doctor we require the patient to:

- Speak to your new practice and ask them to fax a transfer of medical records form to us
- This form must be signed by you for us to transfer your records

We will then transfer your records to your new practice. There is no charge to transfer your medical records to another doctor at a different practice.

FAILURE TO ATTEND FEE

We understand that there may be occasions when you are unable to keep a scheduled appointment. We ask that patients phone ahead, giving us as much notice as possible, and tell us. This will enable us to rebook an appointment for you and open that appointment for another patient.

Failure to provide the practice with sufficient notice could mean that you will be charged a \$40 failure to attend fee.

APPOINTMENTS

Please phone to make an appointment with your preferred doctor during business hours.

We keep a few times open for urgent problems that will be dealt with promptly. Our reception staff may request a brief explanation of the problem when there is a shortage of urgent appointments.

If you anticipate your consultation will take more than 10 minutes with the doctor please make a long appointment.

Long consultations are required for:

- New patients
- Multiple problems/complex issues
- Medical examination for employment or insurance needs

YOUR TEST RESULTS

Please phone the practice after 2.00pm Monday – Friday 5 working days after having your test.

The receptionist will inform you if you need another appointment with the doctor to discuss the result, or if no appointment or action is necessary.

PLEASE PHONE TO CHECK DOCTOR IS RUNNING ON TIME

The surgery makes every effort to make sure you will be seen on time. However, it is always advisable to phone half an hour before your appointment to check that your doctor has not been delayed. Reception may also contact you if there is a lengthy wait, so please ensure we have your correct phone number.

FEES

The Ulladulla Medical Clinic is a privately billing practice. Discounts are available for aged pensioners and health care card holders.

We currently bulk bill Veteran Affairs gold card holders.

Longer appointments and procedures will incur extra costs. A fee schedule is located at reception and in the waiting area.

<u>PLEASE NOTE:</u> Full payment on the day of the consultation is required. The surgery does not issue accounts. EFTPOS and credit cards facilities are available. Personal cheques are not accepted.

TELEPHONE MESSAGES

Telephone messages will be taken by the receptionist and passed on to the doctor who will respond as soon as they can. Emergency calls will be answered immediately by either the doctor or the nurse on duty.

REMINDER SYSTEMS

The Ulladulla Medical Clinic has a reminder system for patients. This is managed by your treating doctor.
